The whole school attendance is **95.17%** this week, which is **BELOW** the school average of **96%** but at the National average of **95%**

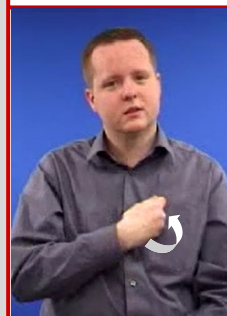

## LEARNING AT CEDARS MANOR SCHOOL

### Nursery

**We have been learning:** about the story of the 3 little pigs and what they made their houses with. We explored the language of strong and weak.

**You can help at home by:** using different materials to build a house. For example; foil, sponge, books, blocks and test if they are strong or weak.

### Reception

**We have been learning:** to explore objects that float and sink from our story 'The Pig in the Pone'. We made boats and tested them.

**You can help at home by:** using household materials and recycling to make a boat and see if it floats with your child.

### Year 1

**We have been learning:** to write about events and feelings in our diary entries.

**You can help at home by:** encouraging your child to talk about their day and write simple sentences about something they have done.

### Year 2

**We have been learning:** about seed and its growth

**You can help at home by:** planting a seed together and watching it grow. Talk about what plants need: water, sunlight, and soil.

### Year 3

**We have been learning:** about different types of angles

**You can help at home by:** pointing out the angles they see in their environment, such as the corners of a book, picture frame or a slice of pizza.

### Year 4

**We have been learning:** the art of simple sewing techniques.

**You can help at home by:** supporting your child to learn and practice some basic sewing skills such as running stitch and whip stitch.

### Year 5

**We have been learning:** to complete their end of term NTS assessments.

**You can help at home by:** talking to the children about skills such as perseverance, resilience and gaining confidence in their own abilities.

### Year 6

**We have been learning:** the songs for our production

**You can help at home by:** helping your child learn the words (they are on Google classroom).

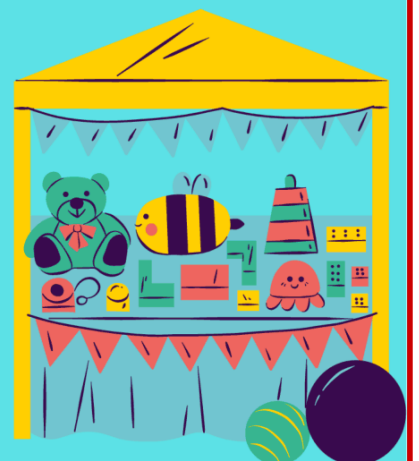
