## NSPCC SPEAK OUT STAY SAFE INTERACTIVE WORKSHOP

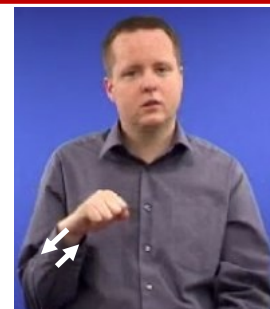

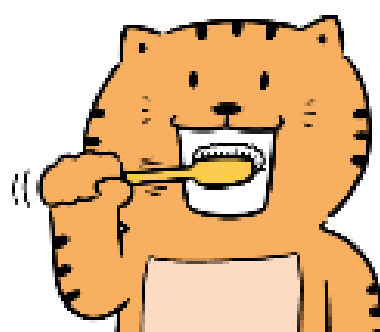
# How to find an NHS dentist

## LEARNING AT CEDARS MANOR SCHOOL

### Nursery

**We have been learning:** We have been reading the Three Billy Goats Gruff'. The children have made trolls out of salt dough and discussed its features.

**You can help at home by:** get your child to survey family and friends to see what their favourite food is, as the goats cross the bridge for their favourite food.

### Reception

**We have been learning:** to read 'Tiddler' by Julia Donaldson and finding out about different sea-life. We made some amazing sea-life art using Cyanotype which uses the sun to change the colours on special paper.

**You can help at home by:** encouraging your child to tell you who Tiddler is and what happened to him in the story.

### Year 1

**We have been learning:** about recognising money e.g coins and notes

**You can help at home by:** showing your child different denominations of money used in the UK.

### Year 2

**We have been learning:** to create a villain character

**You can help at home by:** asking them what the villain wants and how they behave. Then help them draw the villain and one problem they cause.

### Year 3

**We have been learning:** how to measure and draw lines accurately

**You can help at home by:** measuring everyday objects (a pencil, book, spoon) and record the lengths.

### Year 4

**We have been learning:** about balanced arguments.

**You can help at home by:** by asking children to discuss the **For** and **Against** arguments for the use of plastic. What items could they not live without that are made with (or partly made) with plastic?

### Year 5

**We have been learning:** to add and subtract decimals with different numbers of decimal places in math.

**You can help at home by:** discuss different strategies to add and subtract decimals.

### Year 6

**We have been learning:** how to project our voices, how to act and how to sing our songs for our production.

**You can help at home by:** helping your child with their parts in the production.
